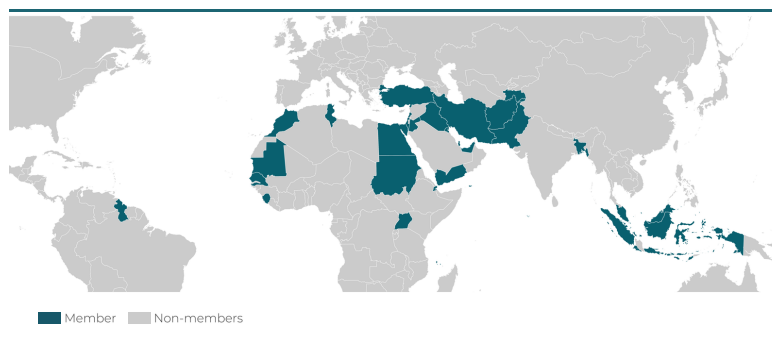

GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE:

Currently, the Permanent Secretariat of ATAIC performs all key executive administrative activities and is comprised of the General Secretary and other staff that are appointed by the SG. The heads of delegation meeting shall be considered as ATAIC supreme body and the general assembly, composed from a high rank employee as a representative of full or associate member appointed from his tax administrations, the HDMs Meeting supervises all ATAIC activities, appoint the secretary-general, as well as approving the work programmes and corresponding budgets. The Secretariat is divided into three sections; the programs section is responsible for conferences, seminars, workshops and training courses, while the section of information, studies and research focus on knowledge and information sharing, the operations section is in charge of the financial and administrative affairs, protocol, public relations, and general coordination.
