GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE:

The WATAF Secretariat, made up of the Executive Secretary and appointed officials, performs administrative tasks and supports members with technical assistance. The annual WATAF General Assembly consists of Heads of tax administrations or their authorised representatives. Its work includes approving work programmes and budgets, electing the WATAF Council and providing it with a mandate to engage development partners, and deciding the membership of each committee. The Council has five elected members who are the Heads of members' tax administrations (or their authorised representatives). Council members hold their office for two years, except Nigeria, which is the 6th and permanent member of the Council.
